



Summer Archaeology in Israel

Option 1: 2 Week Program at the Hebrew University May 16-30

Students will be introduced to the archaeology of Israel through visits to excavations and archaeological labs. Students will also have a chance to work with the Hebrew University teaching collections of pottery and stone tools.

Cost: Students are only responsible for their cost of lodging and subsistence while in Jerusalem. International travel and all program expenses are covered for students currently registered at the University of Toronto.

Credit: This is a non-credit program

Option 2: 2 Week Program at the Hebrew University + Participation in excavation of the site of Huqoq May 16-July 2

Following the Jerusalem program students will participate in the excavation of the site of Huqoq, located on the Sea of Galilee. To learn more about Huqoq, where the spectacular remains of an early synagogue are being uncovered, please visit <http://huqoq.web.unc.edu>.

Cost: Students are responsible for cost of lodging and subsistence while in Jerusalem and the excavation fee for the Huqoq Excavation of \$5,000. Students are encouraged to talk to their college registrar as soon as possible about travel bursaries that might apply to this program.

Credit: Students are eligible for a Y course credit through University of Toronto.
